On January 15, 2018, the MLK Jr. Celebration Committee will host the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Parade. **Line-up begins at 8:00 a.m.** and the **Parade Begins at 9:00 a.m.** at Lincoln Park, 600 N.W. 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue, located at the corner of Sistrunk Boulevard and N.W.19<sup>th</sup> Avenue in Fort Lauderdale. The Parade ends at Esplanade Park located at 400 SW 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33312. Join us at the King Holiday *Celebration of Unity & Multicultural Festival* at Esplanade Park immediately following the parade.

### Parade Rules & Guidelines

In submitting this application, parade participants agree to all conditions set forth. Applicants stipulate that the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Celebration Committee, Inc. and representatives have made no representation, promises or guarantees regarding parade positions, media coverage or preferential treatment of any kind.

In consideration of our inclusion as a participant of the 2019 Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Parade and other good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, participant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Celebration Committee, Inc. its members, and agents against all liability or loss that participant and/or participant’s members, performers and/or volunteers may sustain or incur as a result of claims demands, cost or judgment arising from participants’ involvement in the 2019 Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Parade.

All mechanical equipment must be in sound mechanical condition, equipped with a tow bar or chain, mounted in the front of the vehicle; carry an emergency portable fire extinguisher, be at assigned formation position ready for inspection.

Entry must be covered by adequate insurance.

No commercial advertising of any kind is permitted without prior approval from the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.

All signs are to be approved by the Parade Committee.

**No objects of any kind are to be thrown at the parade spectators.**

Placement in the line of the march of the parade is at the sole discretion of the Parade Committee
